

Vaccination against COVID-19 – Information about the second dose

For you to have the best possible protection against COVID-19, two vaccine doses are needed. This means that you need to be vaccinated on two occasions. This information applies to individuals who have received the first dose of vaccine.

Vaccines against COVID-19 is taken in two doses with a certain amount of time allowed to pass between shots. When you were given dose 1 of the vaccine, you should have received a vaccination card with information on when you are to receive the second dose. If you have lost your vaccination card, contact the location at which you received your first dose.

You need to make an appointment for dose 2 the week before the vaccination is set to take place. For example, if you are set to receive dose 2 during week 6, the appointment should be made during week 5. If you are set to receive dose 2 during week 7, the appointment should be made during week 6, and so on.

Appointments for dose 2 cannot be made at the same time as for dose 1, nor immediately after dose 1. This is to ensure that the responses in the health declaration made ahead of the second dose are as up to date as possible. For example, an individual may have started taking new medication, had a reaction to the first vaccine dose, or become pregnant in the meantime.

Make an appointment for vaccination

If you have a mobile BankID: Make a vaccination appointment via 1177.se/Gavleborg. Select the appointment link for “**Invånare**” (Citizens). Select appointment for **vaccination dose 2**.

If you do not have a mobile BankID: Call **+46 (0)26-15 03 00** to make an appointment. Select button choice 2 for appointment for **vaccination dose 2**.

Please note that you should not travel to the vaccination location if you currently have symptoms.

Cancelling your vaccination appointment

You can cancel the vaccination appointment through the appointment confirmation, which you will receive via SMS or email.

The confirmation contains a cancellation link. If you made your vaccination appointment via telephone, you could cancel the appointment by calling the same number, +46 (0)26-15 03 00.

If you are unable to make it to the vaccination appointment

If you are unable to make it to the vaccination appointment on your own or with the assistance of others, you can request transport free of charge. First make a vaccination appointment, then

call +(0)26-15 03 00 to request transport. Transport can be booked no earlier than 14 days in advance but must be booked no later than 12:00 the day before the vaccination. Remember to cancel your transport if you are unable to use it.
